The Sensory Experiences of Autistic Adolescent Females

This study is part of a research project.

The study will ask about the senses and how they work for autistic females.

It is up to you and your parents/guardian if you want to take part. If you do take part, your parent will be asked to agree by signing a form and emailing it back.

1. What do I have to do to take part?

Your parent or guardian will type your answers to the questions. You tell them what to type.

The survey will ask questions about your sensory experiences. It will ask about the eight senses: touch, smell, taste, hearing, vision, movement, deep pressure and inside your body feelings.

The survey will take 10-20 minutes to complete.

All your answers will be private.

2. What might be hard about taking part?

Some people might get tired when filling in the survey. If this happens, you could take a break and come back to it later. You can finish it over a few days if you need to.

Some people might be sad when they remember sensory experiences. If this happens you can:

- take a break

- talk with a family member or a teacher

You can change your mind and not take part any more at any time.

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
