



Structuring up a Lego Task

- Select various colours of the same size block and two bases to create the task.
- Make sure you have duplicate blocks in the same quantity to create a product sample for you to teach with and for the child to reference.
- Ensure you create a stable base for both the models to be attached to within a container.
- Teach or demonstrate how the model will be created and leave it to the left of the template for reference.
- Place the Lego pieces required in a small container and work from left to right or top to bottom.

This level of structure can be changed depending on the complexity of the task.

These basic principles of structure can be applied to various skills and play activities.
